

Masks

Adjustments to PSA sports arrangments following the release of Guidelines for Education in a High Case Load Setting

Following the recent announcements relating to High Case Load Setting for Western Australian Schools this week, the following adjustments to PSA sport will come into place this round. These adjustments support the broader range of measures occurring in school environments under these settings.

Basketball

- Indoor games on school campuses PLAYERS/COACHING STAFF/OFFICIALS/REVELANT SCHOOL STAFF ONLY. (No spectators)
- Indoor games at community venues (ie Lords/Loftus) Comply with venue protocols, encourage drop off and pick up only, encourage masks and social distancing.
- Outdoor games on school campuses masks unless it is possible to socially distance.

Cricket

• Masks for those not involved on the ground unless it is possible to socially distance.

Rowing

- School tents to be placed apart, encourage masks if on the island. Separate toilet facilities for participants.
- Head of the River will be live-streamed.

Swimming

- Interschool swimming meets: SWIMMERS/COACHES/OFFICIALS/REVELANT SCHOOL STAFF ONLY. (No spectators)
- PSA Interschool Swimming will be live-streamed.

Tennis

- On school campuses masks to be worn unless it is possible to socially distance.
- At external venues, comply with venue protocols, wear masks unless possible to socially distance.

Volleyball

- Indoor games on school campuses PLAYERS/COACHING STAFF/OFFICIALS/REVELANT SCHOOL STAFF ONLY. (No spectators)
- Indoor games at community venues (ie Lords/Loftus) Comply with venue protocols, encourage drop off and pick up only, encourage masks and social distancing.
- Outdoor games on school campuses masks unless it is possible to socially distance.
