

CCGS Year 11 Indigenous Immersion Experiences 2025

SIA is able to offer eight opportunities for an Indigenous immersion experience.

We are also in the early stages of planning up to three other SIA journeys which will be advertised later this year.

Please note the following:

- You nominate the trips you can't attend and the school will determine the trip you will be
 allocated to. Trip allocation will be based on your sporting and extra-curricular activities and
 school requirements.
- We hope to have the groups set before the end of Term 4, 2024 so please make careful note of the following dates and trips and consider any sporting, drama, cadets, or other commitments you may have in 2025.
- At this stage, we estimate the cost to be approximately **\$2000 per trip.** To confirm a place on the journey, we require an indication of your interest and a non-refundable deposit of \$1000. Selection will be based on first-come, first-served basis. The deposit will be refunded should the School cancel the tour or you don't gain a place.
- Once you have been allocated your trip, you will be required to make the balance of payment (\$1,000) by latest Friday 14 February 2025.
- Payment is to be made via the online payments section of CCGS World.
- Unsuccessful applicants will be placed on a waiting list.
- To be included in the selection process, all applicants must complete the Parent Permission form and questionnaire attached and return to Ms Hudson at Student Services
- NO emailed forms will be accepted

Service in Action experiences:
