What is the value of a scholarship?

OBAST Scholarships for entry into Year 7 hold a value of between 50 and 100 per cent of school tuition fees.

Fees and uniform costs

When applying for a scholarship that is less than 100 per cent of fees, it is important to consider your family's ability to fund the remainder of the tuition fees and costs not covered by the scholarship, such as uniforms.

- current tuition fees for Years 7 to 12
- current uniform price lists

What is the duration of a scholarship?

The scholarship, while subject to an annual review, is tenable for the duration of a boy's education at Christ Church Grammar School, from Year 7 to Year 12.

Who is eligible?

- · Australian citizens or permanent residents
- students entering Year 7
- students not currently attending Christ Church Grammar School or another PSA school
- applicants are not required to have any family connection to the School
- those who are unable to afford Christ Church Grammar School tuition fees

Why must I complete a Statement of Financial Position?

Completion of the Statement of Financial Position assists the School in determining a candidate's eligibility for an OBAST scholarship and ability to pay tuition fees. If parents are separated, and both contribute financially to the applicant's upbringing, they must both be included in the statement. If separated parents have new partners who contribute financially to the applicant's upbringing, they must be included in the statement.

What should be included in the handwritten letter to the Principal?

Applicants may like to include information about:

- favourite subjects at school and why they like them
- sports they play or would like to try
- musical instruments they play
- what they like doing outside of school, i.e. hobbies and interests, clubs
- any awards, certificates or trophies they may have received
- community groups they are involved in
- · what they are most proud of
- their family and friends
- what they feel they would contribute to the Christ Church community

Can I submit the application before the deadline?

We encourage early applications. It is prudent to submit your application before the due date in case you experience technical issues. Should you complete the application earlier than the deadline and subsequently receive a new school report for your son, this may be emailed to <u>scholarships@ccgs.wa.edu.au</u> to be included.

When will I be informed of the outcome?

We anticipate all candidates will be informed of the outcome of their scholarship application by April 2025.
