# **POSITION CONTEXT:**

Christ Church Grammar School is an Anglican day and boarding school for boys from Pre-Kindergarten to Year 12. Located in Perth, Western Australia, the School overlooks the Swan River at Freshwater Bay in Claremont. Enrolments are comprehensive and at present are approximately 1700 students including boarders. The School consists of the Preparatory School (PK to Year 6) and the Senior School (Years 7 to 12).

The school's Outdoor Education Centre, Kooringal, is situated on the Murray River near the town of Dwellingup, 110km southeast of Perth in Western Australia. The progressive outdoor education and environmental studies program is compulsory for students in Years 4 to 10 with other optional programs.

Kooringal is a residential centre set on 240 acres; the program consists of residential nature-based learning and journey-based philosophy as part of an extensive expedition program. The successful applicant can expect to work in a wide variety of environments across Western Australia and will be based onsite at Kooringal Outdoor Education Centre.

#### **ROLE:**

The Outdoor Education program is part of the School curriculum. As a consequence the Director is expected to work alongside academic staff at the Claremont campus in developing programs that integrate with subject areas and the emerging National Curriculum. The Year 10 Venture may be based at other venues in the south-west of the State which offer specific facilities for outdoor activities. Beyond Year 10, students are encouraged to plan their own outdoor experiences.

The Director of Kooringal /Co-ordinator of Outdoor Education is responsible for the total operation of the Kooringal campus, including the upkeep, maintenance and development of all facilities, preparation and management of the budget, and planning camps and courses for a wide spectrum of boys at the School which includes boys with special needs. The successful applicant will have sound management and interpersonal skills and be an effective instructor, counsellor and mentor.

# **EXPERIENCE AND QUALIFICATIONS**

This position requires:

- Demonstrated leadership skills and experience in Outdoor Education that reflect the significance of this position.
- Demonstrated ability to build a cohesive team working towards common goals.
- Excellent communication skills, both oral and written, including a high level of computing skills.
- Mentorship of Trainee staff as they work towards certificate qualifications in Outdoor Recreation
- Ability to work well with others in an isolated environment, and deal with issues and conflicts as they arise.
- A demonstrated understanding of the particular needs of boys and how these impact on residential organisation and management in remote settings.
- Demonstrated ability to work automatously with minimal support in a wilderness setting ensuring the safety and care of students and staff.
- Sound knowledge and ability to continuously manage and assess risk in a variety of environments both natural and with man-made influences.
- Ensure the students' Consent2Go medical forms are up to date, downloaded and reviewed prior to any camps, so staff are aware of any medical conditions of camp members.
- Be able to coordinate, manage and/or support groups 24 hours a day in variable environments such as a rescue or evacuation considering the safety of all staff and students.
- Outdoor Instructor for a variety of Outdoor Pursuit Activities, which may include:
  - Expeditions;
  - Navigation;
  - Orienteering;
  - High Ropes Course;
  - Abseiling and Climbing;
  - Bushwalking;

- Kayaking and Canoeing;
- Environmental Education and Sustainability.
- An empathy for the particular issues encountered by international students in outdoor environments and experience in dealing with such issues.
- The position requires the successful applicant to work an irregular roster that may include extended durations in a journey-based setting.
